GENERAL FIRST DAY ON SITE INFORMATION

All personnel who need access to the Dolby Theatre on or after **February 28th** must have an Academy issued credential.

GENERAL PARKING –*Before 3/6/23*

Enter the Ovation Hollywood parking garage at the traffic light on Highland Blvd and Johnny Grant Way and pull a parking ticket from the machine. Before you leave for the day, please see your supervisor for a parking validation. Upon exiting the garage, insert **validation first** and then the parking ticket into the machine. Beginning on 3/6/23, please park in the same garage but enter through Orange Dr – you will need a parking placard for access to the garage.

DOLBY ENTRANCE

The entrance to the Dolby Theatre is located on the 1st floor of the Hollywood and Highland Complex (street level) by the Dolby Theatre Box Office. Enter the double glass doors to the left of the box office.

CREDENTIALS – *Distribution will begin on 2/27, credentials will be mandatory as of 2/28*

The credential office is located in the Echo Park Room (Level 3) of the Loews Hollywood Hotel. Bring the ID you used when completing your credential form (Driver's License or Passport). The credentialing process will take approximately 15 minutes, please allow extra time prior to your work call.
